Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>In India, educational Institutes / Universities remained closed since the mid of March-2020, because of the fast spread of COVID-19. Emergency lockdown might have been an appropriate preventive measure to thwart the fast spread of the dreaded disease, however, it upended the academic life of students, parents and teachers. To combat this inevitable crisis, educational sectors started conducting the online classes. The sudden changeover in teaching / learning method has raised new challenges and opportunities. It is for sure that the traditional chalk and talk methodology is often better than the online sessions for such programs / courses, which have hands-on laboratory based curriculum. Interestingly, the MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses) gained lot of popularity during this period and the higher education fraternity became more acquainted with the MOOCs platforms like SWAYAM, NPTEL, Coursera, edX, Udacity, Future Learn, Simplilearn etc. Nonetheless, the courses offered through this platform were not in exact accordance with the University curriculum. Therefore, online education delivery by the faculty members through online video conferencing platforms like MS Teams, Google Meet, Zoom etc. was the need of the hour. At NSHM, we steered the online education delivery through the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ü Online classes and video lectures through MS Teams. ü Students attendance documentation through our institutional ERP system (TCSiON). ü E-Library facility through TCSiON. ü Providing study materials / notes etc. through the LMS of TCSiON. ü Conduct of internal assessments / examinations through TCSiON / MS Teams / Google forms etc. <p>Thankfully, NSHM successfully completed 150 courses (subjects) having a total of 560 credits (Odd & Even semesters) as per the University curriculum, catering to 616 students (Pharmacy & Management discipline combined). In addition, several students were provided with Coursera & edX licences, to pursue online courses of their choice, as a value addition initiative.</p>
