The minutes of 01.102nd meeting of the Central Council of the Pharmacy Council of India held on 7th & 8th September, 2017 at New Delhi.

*** Consideration of approval of the Diploma, Degree, Pharm.D and Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate), M.Pharm and B.Pharm (Practice) course and examination in Pharmacy at the undermentioned institutions.**

The following resolutions moved by Dr.Shailendra Saraf, Prof. M.D. Karvekar and Shri H.G. Koshia and seconded by Prof. Shivajirao Kadam, Prof. O. P. Kalra and Shri B. Rajan were unanimously passed applicable in respect of all approvals u/s 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 for the purpose of registration as a pharmacist.

A. For the approval u/s 12

- "(1) In pursuance of the provisions of sub section (1) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 (8 of 1948), the Pharmacy Council of India declares the course in Pharmacy (as applicable) conducted by institutions mentioned below to be an approved course of study for the purpose of admission to an approved examination in Pharmacy (as applicable) in respect of number of students and academic session as specified here under:
